WinSport's ski and snowboard hill to reopen Friday

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport is excited to announce that the ski and snowboard hill at Canada Olympic Park will reopen on Friday, following four days of closures due to the cold.

The hill will be open on Friday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Holiday hours begin Saturday, with skiers and snowboarders able to carve turns from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily until January 8th. The hill will be closed Christmas Day.

The Servus Tube Park will be open daily from December 24th to January 8th (except for Christmas Day) with three sessions each day starting at 10 a.m.
